I understand that by giving this authorization during the above period (or until my child has returned to the host family home or UCEUS Representative):		
• If traveling without host family or WorldBound accompaniment, neither WorldBound, UCEUS, designated chaperones, the host family, nor the international partner will necessarily be able to control the whereabouts of the child, may not be able to immediately access the child nor be held responsible in any way in relation to the child's safety and welfare.		
• If traveling without host family or WorldBound accompaniment, WorldBound, UCEUS, designated chaperones, the host family, and the international partner will only resume their normal responsibility when the child has reached a trip destination and been united with their WorldBound chaperone or returned to the permanent host family.		
• WorldBound, UCEUS, designated chaperones, and the host family cannot guarantee the child will be allowed to re-enter the United States after travel outside of the United States.		
• In the event the child is detained or deported upon attempt to re-enter the USA, neither WorldBound, UCEUS, designated chaperones, nor the host family shall be responsible for any additional costs or hardship incurred. This includes but is not limited to additional costs for accommodation, food, travel expenses, or re-entry fees.		
WorldBound and UCEUS will not be held liable or responsible if the student is held up, not permitted to return to their host family, the U.S., or their home country, or their visa is cancelled due to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19).		
I agree with the terms outlined therein. In addition, I understand that I will be required to always maintain the program rules and Code of Conduct of WorldBound and UCEUS. I have read and understand this contract. I understand that violations may result in disciplinary action and/or removal from any excursion, return to the host family and removal from the academic program.		
I further agree that WorldBound and its designated chaperones are authorized to seek medical care for the child should such a need arise. All rights regarding medical care granted to UCEUS shall be considered extended to WorldBound.
